This is to confirm that Daniel Mechanical has successfully completed its work on Nielsen Dillingham Builders' project at Pt. Loma in San Diego.

It included the manufacture and installation of numerous custom spools of fiberglass ductwork for the Waste Water Treatment Plant's Odor Control Foul Air Exhaust System.
